## EXHIBITOR BUSINESS NAME

### 1) PRELIMINARY WARNING

"BolognaFiere" means Fiere Internazionali di Bologna S.p.A.

"Organizer" means: Avenue media srl

### 2) GENERAL PROVISIONS

#### 2.A - EXHIBITION DATE, VENUE AND TIME

The Exhibition will take place from 30<sup>th</sup> March to 1<sup>st</sup> April 2022 in the BolognaFiere Exhibition Center from 9.30 to 18.00 (on Friday from 8.00 to 17.00) Exhibitors will be able to access the stands from 9.30 am.

#### 2.b - Stand availability - delivery

The stands in the free area will be available to Exhibitors starting from March 28<sup>th</sup> at 8.00 and must be completed by 19.00 on the same day. The Exhibitor must ensure that the chosen exhibitor undertakes to comply with the aforementioned term, inserting the clause for the realization times in the contract.

The pre-furnished stands will be made available to Exhibitors on March 29<sup>th</sup> from 8.00 am.

#### 2.C - ACCESS to the exhibition center during the stand set up period

Access to the Bologna Exhibition Center can only take place upon accreditation of the Exhibitor's personal data on the appropriate Gate BolognaFiere site. Exhibitors and their stand builders / suppliers, who will not be accredited to this site, and will not print the entry documents, will not be authorized to enter the Exhibition Center during the set-up and dismantling periods of the event.

A specific password will be sent to each Exhibitor at the e-mail address indicated in the participation form for the event, to access his / her own reserved area, in which he / she must enter the data regarding the personnel and vehicles of his / her company, for printing the related entry documents. Finally, the procedure provides that the Exhibitor carries out the Assignment procedure for his own fitting and supplying companies; thanks to the Assignment it will be possible to transmit, to the aforementioned companies, a password that will allow them to register employees and vehicles within their own personal reserved area and print the relevant entry documents.

The suppliers / forwarders who enter the district, to confer material on behalf of the Exhibitor, must also have a specific Transport Document (DDT) with the identification data of the Exhibitor of interest, such as the Exhibitor's company name, pavilion, stand. Access to the Exhibition Center will be denied to suppliers who present themselves with a Transport Document without such data.

According to the provisions of current legislation on health and safety at work, it is the responsibility of the Exhibitor (client) to verify, in relation to the works to be entrusted, the technical-professional requirements of the contractors, of all the operating companies and of the self-employed workers who will be involved in the Exhibition Center on behalf of the Exhibitor. During the stand set-up period, people and vehicles must be admitted to the Exhibition Center according to the following schedule:

March 28, 2022 from 8.00 to 18.00 with the possibility for the stand construction company to be present inside the Exhibition Center until 19.00. On March 29, 2022, the day before the opening of the Exhibition, from 8.00 to 19.00 no stand set-up work will be allowed, but only sample arrangements, graphics or other activities involving the use of only manual tools. Access to pavilions and other internal structures for vehicles, forklifts and any other NON-ELECTRIC or internal combustion vehicles is prohibited. Parking in the proximity of the pavilions must be limited to the time strictly necessary for the unloading and loading of goods and equipment: vehicles not used for these operations must be parked in the areas reserved for parking.

In particular, it is not allowed to unload and park containers or detachable parts of non-self-propelled vehicles.

BolognaFiere and the organizer will be able to define, also for the purposes of workplace safety legislation, particular criteria for access to the Exhibition Center, as well as limit the access of vehicles and / or foresee charges in the event that vehicles remain outside the spaces and / or from the times defined by the Organizer.

In particular, if the vehicles remain in the Exhibition Center beyond the agreed times, the Exhibitor, through whose password the vehicle has been credited, will be charged the amount of € 500.00 plus VAT.

It is also strictly forbidden, for safety reasons, to park vehicles inside the Exhibition Center during its closing times. In the event of unauthorized stay, BolognaFiere will take steps to obtain the forced removal of vehicles outside the Exhibition Center, at the risk and expense of the owner of the vehicle.

For safety-related reasons, Exhibitors and stand makers operating on their behalf are prohibited from using their own forklifts, self-propelled cranes, aerial platforms, etc. within the Exhibition Center; for these needs they must contact BolognaFiere, to guarantee the strictest observance of the safety rules.

The above provisions do not apply to transport vehicles equipped with a crane arm on board, which can operate inside the pavilions only if equipped with pipes for the disposal of the exhaust fumes from the engines outside the pavilions themselves.

In the event of the introduction and use of lifting equipment owned by Exhibitors or their suppliers, BolognaFiere will block or immediately remove the vehicle at the risk and expense of the exhibitor or the owner of the vehicle itself.

#### 2.d - Removal of samples and dismantling. Return of booth space

Access to the Exhibition area for the removal of samples and dismantling will be as follows:

- Friday 1<sup>st</sup> April 2022 from 18.30 to 20.00

**(only removal of samples)**

- Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> April 2022 from 8.00 to 18.00

with the possibility for the booth decorators to be inside the Exhibition area on Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> April to continue the work of dismantling for another hour until 7.00pm.

From 6.30 pm to 7.00 pm on March 31<sup>st</sup>, materials will not be allowed to leave the Exhibition Center.

The access of vehicles in the areas and halls will be regulated as for the construction work (see art.2.C).

The clearing of the stands, wherever located, must be completed by 7.00 pm on April 2, 2022.

Failing this, this will be done ex officio considering what is left on the stand as waste material to be sent to public landfills and the Exhibitor will be required to reimburse all direct and indirect expenses incurred for the clearing, currently with a minimum of € 300.00 for every 16 m<sup>2</sup> of surface and without prejudice to any refunds for greater damages.

The Exhibitor assumes all responsibility for damage or theft that may occur both during the course of the Exhibition, during the set-up and later.

## 2.E – Methods of Payment

The payment of the fees due for participation in the Exhibition must be made within the times and in the manner provided for in the application form.

The “exit voucher”, although it cannot be issued to Exhibitors who have not settled any direct or indirect debt position, will not be a receipt for payment of the amounts due for participation in the Exhibition, and will be valid for the only vehicle indicated therein.

## 2.f-Insurance-exemptions,assumptions and limitations of liability

During the opening hours of the pavilions, the Exhibitor must supervise his own stand directly or through his own staff. BolognaFiere, while providing a general day and night surveillance service within the Exhibition Center during the closing hours to the public and exhibitors for the entire duration of the Exhibition and for all the days scheduled for the preparation and clearing of the stands, is exempt from any and all liability for theft and / or damage that may occur towards the Exhibitor.

The Exhibitor will also be in charge towards BolognaFiere for all direct and indirect damages that for any reason are related to him or to personnel operating on his behalf (including damage caused by the fittings or systems carried out on his own or by third parties appointed by him, even if tested by BolognaFiere).

Reimbursements for damages resulting from theft or damage that may occur to the Exhibitor, even outside the opening hours of the halls (including all the days scheduled for setting up and clearing the stands), will be made only through insurance coverage and within the limits / conditions provided therein.

The Exhibitor will benefit from the following insurances issued by BolognaFiere and agreed with the Organizer:

- a) All Risks guarantee (including fire and theft) for material and direct damage to furnishings, fittings, equipment and goods in the stand, excluding money, valuables, valuables and the like and excluding software installed on electronic computers and excluding damage from non-use of furniture, fittings, equipment and goods during the period of the Exhibition: coverage € 40,000.00 at first absolute risk (including fire and theft), with an absolute deductible of € 300.00, for any high damage to € 600.00 for damage occurring after the end of the event.
- b) guarantee for civil liability towards third parties, including fire damage: claim limit €50,000,000.00;
- c) guarantee for Civil Liability towards employees: maximum amount per claim €3,000,000.00 with a limit of €2,000,000.00 per person;
- d) waiver by the Insurer of any compensation towards all Exhibitors, the Organizer and BolognaFiere

The insurance coverage indicated above is governed by the conditions and limitations that the Exhibitor may request from the Organizing Secretariat of the event, and which will be reported in the documentation relating to the event itself. These coverages do not exclude the liability of the Exhibitor for all risks which, according to the insurer's independent assessment, were not guaranteed or which exceed the coverage limits indicated above. The Exhibitor himself will have to provide the appropriate additional coverage.

In particular, depending on the existence of a video surveillance system, the Exhibitor acknowledges that, in the event of theft, the related report to the Public Authority must reach the Insurer within seven days of the conclusion of the event and that failure to comply with the term may result in the loss of the right to compensation.

The Insurer will also handle the claims management and the settlement procedures at the end of the event.

In any case, the Exhibitor undertakes to include the insurer's waiver of any recourse action against the Exhibitors, the Organizer and BolognaFiere in the supplementary coverages, and failing that, he will have to keep them relieved of any action that may be carried out in their regard.

Having acknowledged the above, the Exhibitor, however, (for himself and for his collaborators or agents) expressly excludes the Organizer and BolognaFiere from any responsibility for losses or damage that for any reason may occur in the exhibition space assigned to him, during the performance of the Exhibition or during the setting up and dismantling of the stand, and what is found therein, and assumes responsibility for any damage caused to third parties by the management of the exhibition space or by what is placed in it, and not covered in the terms and methods indicated above or activated by the Exhibitor himself.

The Organizer and BolognaFiere decline any responsibility for consequential damages, image damage, loss of turnover, etc. Even for direct damages, the Exhibitor accepts that the Organizer and BolognaFiere limit their liability to the limits and ceilings of the insurance coverage listed above. The Exhibitor accepts these limitations of liability.

## 3) Booth decoration and prohibitions

### 3.A – Definition Of Type Of Booth Decoration And Approval Procedure

Booth decorations, regardless of their surface area, are classified as following:

- STANDARD booth decoration
- NON- STANDARD booth decoration

NON-STANDARD booth decorations are considered when just one of the following features are present:

- “American” type metal structures with free structural light more than 8.00 mt height or with a overall spread more than 32.00 mt
- Horizontal structures of metal or other materials with a free light more than 4.50 mt height
- mezzanine with rooms on the first level, even if off-limits to the public
- platforms with a height of over 0.80 m

Booth decoration with height more than 3,50 mt has to proceed with a proper checking test.

All structures built in outdoor areas with an area greater than 75 m<sup>2</sup> are also to be considered non-standard.

Considering that the Exhibition Center has received the usability of the exhibition spaces according to a basic scheme of traditional set-up, or with the parameters defined STANDARD, it is mandatory for the Exhibitor who intends to propose a set-up having even one of the characteristics listed above, to transmit via fax or certified e-mail to the Organizer and to BolognaFiere for the possible approval, by 5 January 2022, of the non-standard set-up project, stamped and signed by a qualified technician.

In the case that the Exhibitor is not in possession of a non-standard set-up project signed by a qualified technician, it is possible to request a prior verification from BolognaFiere using the forms available on the web portal [www.befair.eu](http://www.befair.eu).

For non-standard structures, in the case that the relevant stamped and signed project is not sent to Bolognafiere, verification and validation will be carried out with a charge to the Exhibitor equal to double the rate foreseen for the service, indicated in the forms on the aforementioned web portal.

In any case, BolognaFiere reserves the right not to allow the set-up of non-standard booths that have not been previously approved.

Static testing is mandatory for non-standard set-ups and will be carried out exclusively by BolognaFiere. As consequence the Exhibitor will be charged the amount corresponding to the type of set-up, as indicated in the forms on the web portal [www.befair.eu](http://www.befair.eu).

The construction of metal structures (“American” type) of particular complexity (overall development greater than 32.00 mt, including both vertical and horizontal structures, and / or free structural span greater than 8.00 mt), or structures horizontal metal or other materials with free span greater than 4.50 mt, as well as mezzanines, is in any case subject to the transmission (by fax or certified mail) to BolognaFiere of the design of the structure, signed by a qualified technician, accompanied by a report calculation including the load conditions that will occur in the assembly and

disassembly phases, based on the expected construction methodology, as well as the certificate of correct set up, at the end of the work, signed by a qualified technician.

In any case, BolognaFiere always has the right to evaluate the designs of booths which, in terms of importance, size and danger, are outside the standards of traditional booths; the Exhibitor is obliged to provide the technical documentations and the names of the technicians responsible for the structural part, for the fittings part, for the aspects concerning health and safety at work as well as for the systems. The same obligation exists for booths built in external areas. BolognaFiere will be entitled to request the intervention of the Supervisory Commission for public entertainment venues.

### 3.b – Booth Decoration

The Exhibitor must restrict the layout within the assigned area, identifiable either by separating walls, or painted lines, or adhesive tapes, where no other reference elements exist.

In the pavilions the booths must not exceed the standard height of 2.50 m. In order to take into account the thicknesses due to raised floors, lighting bodies, supports of lighting bodies, including structures, an additional margin of 0.50 mt will be allowed at the limit of the height defined above, thus bringing it to a maximum of 3.00 mt, provided that the structures whose sides overlook the contiguous stands are perfectly finished and painted in a full colour with a neutral colour.

The suspended loads and the related suspension systems must be made according to the provisions of the Circular Letter of the domestic affairs Ministry dated 01/04/2011, or by providing, in addition to the main connection system (i.e. tierod, band, rope, chain, rod), also a safety link (i.e. tierod, band, rope, chain, extensible fall arrest systems, etc.). By "suspended loads" we mean American structures (simple or "ring" type) or other types of beams / structures and all related loads (but not limited to: screens, projectors, loudspeakers, lights, motors for lifting of other sub-structures, etc.) that are attached to an upper or lower structure or by any lifting device. The above elements must have all the documentations according to the above Circular Letter.

The hangings on fixed structures in halls 31 and 32 (exhibition area) are not allowed.

The Exhibitor must keep fire extinguishers inside the stand in accordance with the law in an adequate quantity for the area of the booth, as provided by BolognaFiere, in a clearly visible and accessible and adequately marked position.

The glass walls in direct contact with the public must follow the current regulations and UNI standards. Booth coverings are not permitted in halls 31 and 32.

Any responsibility regarding the statics and compliance of the fitting materials with the fire prevention regulations currently in force is the sole responsibility of the Exhibitor, who expressly exempts BolognaFiere for damage coming from design and construction defects, including the dimensions coming from the detailed drawings of the occupied area.

Any works involving changes to the state of the buildings and other materials of BolognaFiere (reinforcements, modifications, excavations, drilling of fixtures, walls, structures, columns, floors), can only be carried out with the prior written authorization of BolognaFiere, at the expense and responsibility of the exhibitor. This responsibility remains with the Exhibitor for the entire period of the Exhibition and until the return of the stand to BolognaFiere. Before the start of the works, the Exhibitor is required to pay the Organizer the amount of the expenses necessary for the return to the original state which the Organizer will provide directly.

### 3.C Waste Management booth

#### set-up and dismantling

It is forbidden for Booth Decorators / Exhibitors, during all phases of the event, to leave waste materials and / or special waste in the exhibition areas and in the perimeter areas of the Exhibition Center.

Waste and residual materials from set-up and dismantling work must be disposed of by the Exhibitor and / or his representatives, and the hallways of the halls must be kept free of any type of materials.

#### the elimination of waste and construction residues is the responsibility of the Exhibitor and / or his representatives

Verification of the correct application of the provisions for the management of waste and residual materials will be carried out by staff appointed by BolognaFiere, present in each hall, during the opening hours of the exhibi-

tion area. The individual discrepancy detected will be recorded and transmitted to the specific internal departments.

Any discrepancy will result in the application of a penalty towards the Exhibitor by way of reimbursement of the expenses necessary for BolognaFiere for the management of abandoned waste, for a minimum amount of € 300.00 + VAT for every 16 m<sup>2</sup> of area occupied by the Exhibitor.

#### Exhibition

The waste produced during the exhibition must be disposed of in the ecological areas present and reported in the Exhibition Center and sorted according to specific type (paper, glass, metal, plastic and undifferentiated).

### 3.d - Prohibitions

It is forbidden for Exhibitors, in particular:

- to place material on the structures of the halls, on the walls, on the piling for lighting, etc.;
- to hang-up to the above parts any posters, cables, panels, banners, stickers;
- in order to fasten carpet or similar materials to the floor, it is absolutely forbidden to use double-sided adhesive tapes with strong adhesion and with internal paper support or with weak structure;
- to damage the equipment owned by BolognaFiere and the structures of the halls;
- to use their own lifting equipment;
- to leave waste materials and / or waste of any kind;
- to carryout any show or entertainment activities, of any type and characteristics, even if limited to the booth or aimed at presenting products without prior authorization from the Avenuemedia Organization; it is the sole responsibility of the Exhibitor to obtain any authorizations from the health and public safety authorities, and, in general, from the authorities in charge, for the above initiatives, if and as required;
- to go inside the Exhibition Center, during the period of opening to the public, using vehicles other than cars;
- in accordance with the policy adopted by BolognaFiere to reduce the use of plastic, the use of cutlery, crockery, straws, glasses and in general of disposable and non-recyclable plastic material is prohibited within the exhibition area. The Exhibitor is responsible for compliance with this rule also by its suppliers and will be called to respond in case of non-compliance.

The Exhibitor is in charge of civil and criminal liability for any damage caused by non-compliance or violation of the regulations in force and of all the prescriptions contained in these Regulations and in the Safety File, also undertaking to hold BolognaFiere relieved of any claims made for compensation from third parties.

The Exhibitor must inform his staff and the companies operating for him in the Exhibition area about the requirements and prohibitions of these Regulations and in the Safety File about the general conditions for participation in the Exhibition.

Failure to comply with these regulations and with those on the subject set out in the general conditions of participation entitles BolognaFiere to take precautionary measures against the company, for example, with an irregular fire prevention position, which may entail, in the event that measures are adopted supplementary to the global safety conditions, the debit of the corresponding expenses that are previously assessed not less than € 300.00 / module or the order of partial or total demobilization of the stand and the declaration of non-usability of the stand itself.

## 4) GENERAL AND TECHNICAL SERVICES

Within the limits of the facilities at its disposal, BolognaFiere can supply the individual stands with electricity, water and compressed air, as well as connect the stands themselves to the telephone and data networks.

### 4.A – SERVICE ASSISTANCE TO EXHIBITORS

The Organizer, through its Exhibition Secretariat, is available to Exhibitors to provide all technical information on the general services provided within the Exhibition areas.

#### 4.b – RESPONSIBILITY OF THE SERVICES

BolognaFiere rules but does not directly supply the services and, therefore, disclaims any personal responsibility for their execution.

### 5) SPECIAL SERVICES

#### 5.A – ENTRY CARDS FOR EXHIBITORS AND CAR PARKING PASS

The exhibitor will receive free of charge the following quantity of entry cards:

- 2 entry cards for stand up to 24 m<sup>2</sup>
- 3 entry cards for stand up to 48 m<sup>2</sup>
- 5 entry cards for stand over 48 m<sup>2</sup>

The Exhibitor will receive a pass for car parking, whatever the space of the stand. This badge will entitle the car to park in the parking areas provided by BolognaFiere until the available space is exhausted.

The Exhibitor is responsible for the correct use of these documents and the behaviour of those who use them.

#### 5.b – CUSTOMER INVITATION CARDS AND STAMPS

The following material will be sent automatically and free of charge to the Exhibitor:

- N ° 50 invitation cards

Requests for any further quantities (which will be satisfied until the printed matter is exhausted, with shipping costs to be paid by the Exhibitor) must be addressed to Avenue media srl.

#### 5.C - DIRECTORY

The directory will contain the indications of the Exhibitors accepted within 45 days before the opening date of the Exhibition and - as regards the insertion of the name and the identification of the product sector - the data provided with the application form will be considered valid.

#### 5.d – “NEWS AND INVENTIONS” SERVICE

If the Exhibitors present new inventions, new procedures or modifications of a certain relevance made to machinery or manufacturing processes, they will be able to promptly notify them using the appropriate “News and inventions” form, so as to allow the Organizer to inform the press in the forms that it deems most appropriate.

#### 5.E – HOTEL BOOKING SERVICE

The hotel booking service is carried out by the BolognaFiere Official Supplier, Bologna Welcome, to whom the Exhibitor must contact directly, using the specific methods indicated on the website [www.pestmed.it](http://www.pestmed.it).

This service is also ruled but not organized by BolognaFiere, which therefore declines any responsibility for any complaints.

Any complaints must be forwarded in writing directly to the Official Supplier and must be communicated, for information only, to BolognaFiere.

#### 5.F - MUSIC BROADCASTS, COPYRIGHT PAYMENTS

Exhibitors are not normally allowed to use devices for reproducing music and sounds. Any exceptions may be authorized in writing.

The authorization may be revoked with immediate effect at any time, by means of a simple written notice.

Any authorization does not exempt the Exhibitor from using the equipment in such a way as not to disturb other Exhibitors and visitors, with particular attention to the regulations on noise pollution (maximum limit allowed by law) and also does not exempt from the obligation to comply, at their own expense, with the provisions of current copyright laws.

### 6) SPECIAL REGULATIONS

#### 6.A - ACCESS WITH BAGS OR SUITCASES

BolognaFiere will have the right to ban the entry to the Exhibition areas or to any specific pavilion with bags, suitcases or other box, requiring them to be deposited in the specific cloakroom.

#### 6.b - ACCESS WITH DOGS OR ANIMALS

The access with dogs is not allowed.

#### 6.C - NO PHOTOGRAPHIC AND CINEMATOGRAPHIC SHOOTING, AND NO ACCESS TO THE EXHIBITION AREAS WITH CAMERAS

It is forbidden to enter the exhibition areas with cameras, video cameras, video recorders and any other kind of camera without the prior authorization of BolognaFiere, and it is forbidden to photograph and film the interiors of the exhibition areas by any means, stands and exhibited goods, without the prior permission of BolognaFiere and the owner of the stand.

#### 6.d - RADIO EQUIPMENT

Operators who intend to make use of radio equipment (transceivers, radio microphones, radio cameras, etc.) are required to use devices compliant with the regulations (directive 99/05 CE - CE mark) and to obtain the appropriate authorization (art. 107 paragraph 10 of Legislative Decree 259/2003 - Electronic Communications Code), if necessary, as well as operating in the allowed radio bands. For the completion of the necessary practices, interested parties may refer to the website of the Ministry for Economic Development <http://www.ispettoratoemiliaromagna.altervista.org/index.php/aree-tematiche/apparati-di-debole-potenza>.

### 7) SUPERVISORY POWERS AND ABILITY TO ACT FROM BOLOGNAFIERE

BolognaFiere ensures that its regulatory provisions and the general conditions of participation contracts are observed; those who enter the Exhibition Center are obliged to observe the dispositions and prescriptions that BolognaFiere will impart at the entrance and inside the same with specific signs, with written notices, with amplified announcements, as well as through the service staff or by any other means, with the clarification that the amplified press releases and the orders given by the service personnel prevail over the other notices.

Furthermore, BolognaFiere has the right to adopt the measures it deems most appropriate at any time and which the Exhibitor must immediately apply, with regard to fire prevention, health and safety at work, prevention of injuries and damages, safety of participants and visitors.
